EXPEDITION TEAM

Pre-Embarkation

GET CERTIFIED


45-30 days prior to departure

-  **ONLINE TRAINING**
Complete online health & safety training program via an online learning management system
-  **IMO CERTIFICATION**
Must have: Current IMO Medical Certificate – Fit for Duty
-  **VISIT YOUR GP**
Your doctor completes your Aurora Medical Form


GET READY


Preparing for departure


 **REDUCE RISK**
Minimise risk of exposure, avoid hotspots for 14 days prior to boarding and minimise activities to essential only

 **COVID-19 TEST**
PCR Test 72-48 hours prior to embarkation then you must minimise social contact

Day of departure

 **TRAVEL SAFE**
Wash hands, wear a mask when travelling and maintain social distancing

 **PRE BOARDING SCREENING + ANTIGEN TEST**
Adjacent to vessel or at a selected venue close by

 **BOARD**
If medically approved to sail and tests results have been provided and are negative.

TRAINING

- Expedition team induction and health & safety training

ONGOING HEALTH PROTOCOLS

- Daily health screening & temperature checks
- If you're travelling on multiple voyages, you will be required to have an Antigen Screening or PCR Test between voyages

PUBLIC HEALTH MITIGATION

- Hand hygiene
- Social distancing
- Masks
- Cleaning and disinfection
- Operations & activity groups staggered

RESPONSE PLAN

Medically developed and Government approved protocols if a suspected or confirmed case of COVID occurs on board

VESSEL

- Isolation Cabins with negative ventilation
- Immediately return to pre-agreed port
- Deep cleaning of entire vessel in port

PATIENTS CARE

- Specially trained COVID response doctor, nurse, health and safety officer
- Medical and laboratory facility
- Telehealth support
- On shore medical care

CLOSE CONTACTS

- Daily health checks and screening
- Testing
- Quarantine close contacts in separate cabins

MANAGEMENT OF OTHERS

- All other passengers, non-essential crew and e-team quarantined in their cabin during return voyage to port
- Testing conducted on all onboard prior to port arrival
