

Your health & safety is our number one priority

As part of our commitment to ensure that we are doing small ship expedition travel in the safest and most enjoyable way possible.

During your voyage, please follow all social distancing, face covering, and handwashing policies to ensure everyone's safety.

We will continuously evaluate our health and safety protocols and update the information as required in accordance with the latest advice and regulations.



Onboard

To reduce the chance of potential cross contamination, certain on-board activities will have to be conducted in pre-determined groups.

At all times social distancing of 1.5 metres, 4 sqm rule in indoor public spaces, 2 sqm rule in outdoor public spaces must be respected.

Facemasks are mandatory when transiting public spaces, with the exemption of Restaurants and Bars.



Masks

We encourage expeditioners to bring their own masks on board. We will provide disposable masks on board.



Briefings & Lectures

All briefings and lectures will be provided to individual groups including the Welcome and Emergency Briefings.

We will provide 2 lectures at the same time. One in the Lecture Hall and the other in the Observation Lounge.

Lectures run at the same time and then they are repeated 3 times so that everyone will have the opportunity to attend.



Landings

We perform landings by groups and we will rotate groups between landings in such a way that each group has the chance to of being the "first group to land".

The numbers of expeditioners per zodiac will be as per our standard practice of 10 plus the driver. In the zodiac, everyone is required to wear a mask.

All expeditioners will need to keep their personal flotation device (PFD) on during the landing.



Ashore | On Land

On shore/land – if you keep a 1.5 metre or 2 sqm distance from others (*NB: excluding your travelling companions*), you can be on land without a mask.
