

# Luggage Allowances *for Charter Flights to Antarctica*



## Fly/Sail & Sail/Fly Voyages

If you are travelling on a charter flight to Antarctica on DAP Airways, there is baggage and weightage allowances that the aircraft can safely fly with.

This is determined by the airline and we cannot exceed the permitted load.

It is important that all guests follow the luggage /weight allowance protocols.

### How much luggage can I bring?

20 kg is permitted for check-in luggage.

Plus 7 kg for carry-on luggage that conform to these dimensions to fit into the overhead compartments:

Height: 45 cm

Width: 40 cm

Depth: 20 cm

### Technical Equipment:

Scuba divers and skiers are permitted to bring additional gear for their activities as this is counted as technical equipment.

### Can I bring additional baggage?

This will depend on the overall load of the flight. DAP weighs each piece of luggage and they may offload pieces if the permitted load is exceeded.

### Can I pay for additional luggage?

Aurora Expeditions does not charge a fee for additional luggage. For safety reasons, the permitted load determined by DAP Airways cannot be exceeded.
