## Health & Safety Protocols Onboard

In the unlikely event of a positive COVID case/s on board, the following protocols will be followed:

1.



The individual/s will move to an isolation cabin that is equipped with negative pressure.

- Aurora has dedicated isolation cabins on board if required.

2.



The individual/s will undergo a PCR test.

- Close contacts will be determined and will also undergo a PCR test

3.



If the individual/s tests positive they will quarantine in the isolation cabin (for 7 days -until a negative result is received) and will be in the care of the Doctor/Nurse onboard.

Food will be delivered to the isolation cabins (Breakfast/Lunch/Tea/Dinner).

4.



Every individual on board will then also be tested via an Antigen Test

5.



The frequency of cleaning across the entire ship will be increased



- In the event that the individual/s health deteriorates into a severe case as determined by the Doctor;



- The individual/s Travel Insurance provider will be contacted and the individual/ and their close contacts will be evacuated off the Ship (taken to Punta Arenas and the next steps will be determined by the Health Ministry of Chile)



- In the unlikely event of a broader outbreak of COVID as determined by the Ship & Medical Authorities – the ship will return to port
